#### Executive Report – 2022

- 2022 Income: **\$123K** (down from \$134K in 2021)
- 2022 Expenses: \$3K (2.5% of income)



- 2023 Grants pledged: 31 grants totaling \$140K
  - (includes \$15K from C-W Rotary Foundation, \$5K from Camas Lions Foundation)
- Assets as of Dec 31, 2022: **\$221K** including:
  - \$102K endowment
  - \$60K in emergency and reserve funds

### 2022 Fundraising Events

- GiveMore24 on September 22, 2022
  - Organized by the Community Foundation of SW WA
  - Raised **\$23,070**, including \$11,700 in matching funds
  - 2022 was the last year for GiveMore24. We may participate in the **GiveBig** state-wide event in 2024.
- Outlaw Festival will be a 2-day event in 2023!!!
  - In 2022, we raised \$3,153 (event) + \$2,533 (auction)
  - This year, scheduled for June 16 & 17 at 54'40° Brewing
  - Adult admission is \$10 each, plus online auction & raffle

In 2022, the C-W Community Chest and C-W Rotary Foundation distributed \$140,290 in grants to 35 local agencies, providing over 40,000 individual services, including:

- 26 volunteers delivered 500 emergency preparedness kits to seniors by Meals on Wheels People
- 26 foster youth and children of incarcerated parents enjoyed 3 days of summer camp, thanks to 65 adult volunteers and Teen Reach Adventure Camp
- 888 children, 130 teens, and 209 adults participated in the Summer Reading Program at the Camas Public Library sponsored by the Friends and Foundation of the Camas Library
