Executive Report – as of Dec 31, 2024



- 2024 FY Jan 1-Dec 31st Income: **\$194K**
 - \$167K donations, \$16K events, \$2K sponsorships, \$8K investments
- 2024 Expenses: **\$4.5K** (mostly insurance)
- 2024 Grants dispersed: **34 grants** totaling **\$138K**
- Assets as of Dec 31, 2024: **\$285K** including:
 - \$178K endowment
 - \$46K in emergency and reserve funds
- Anticipated grants to be disbursed in 2025: **\$141K**
